Randy Schmitz, Extrication Instructor and Calgary Firefighter will instruct this event. This session will provide responders with excellent learning and networking opportunities.

This seminar will take place over two 8 hour days with a mixture of both theory and hands on practical training. We will be taking **40 students** and they will be split into groups for the practical training. We will have four Instructors with multiple pits, offering more hands on time for the participants.
