Rocky Mountain Phoenix is again offering training opportunities to our customers.

This June we will be hosting another two day training seminar for Emergency Responders on new vehicle technology and advanced extrication. The instructor for this event will be Randy Schmitz, Extrication Instructor and Calgary Firefighter, along with fellow instructors from Alberta VX. This session will provide responders with an excellent learning and networking opportunity. The course will focus on tool technique, hand tools, and lifting and cribbing.

This seminar will be two 8 hour days with a mixture of both theory and hands on practical evolutions. We will be taking 40 students this year and they will be split into four groups for the practical training. We will have four Instructors with four pits, offering more hands on time for the participants.
